Leave the pier by open jeeps and reach Corcovado hill, located in the Tijuca forest, the largest urban forest in the world; you will admire one of Rio's most famous postcards: Christ the Redeemer chosen as one of the seven world wonders. The excursion will pass by through the traditional Santa Teresa borough with its pleasant atmosphere due to the mansions from the beginning of the century that today houses some of the most important art Centres with lots of craftsmanship galleries not to mention it is the only district that you can find the old English trolleys which still works as a means of transportation for the locals. We will head to the Corcovado hill to see and admire some of the most traditional Brazilian beaches; Copacabana, Ipanema and Leblon, the Rodrigo de Freitas lagoon with its salt and fresh water, the botanical garden and the centennial palm trees. From the top you will also be able to see the Maracanã stadium, Guanabara Bay and the Sugar Loaf. On the return to the pier we will pass by the Copacabana and Ipanema beaches. Remarks: This tour is not suitable for wheelchair guests. This excursion will not be cancelled due to weather conditions (rain). The itinerary and venues visited in this excursion may be altered in calls during the Brazilian Carnival. Jeeps are parked outside the terminal in Rio de Janeiro and depending where the ship docks alongside the pier, guests may have to take a shuttle bus from the ship to the terminal and may have to walk up to 500 meters to the entrance of the terminal to meet the vehicle. This is an amazing combination of the best that the city of Rio de Janeiro has to offer. Departing from the port towards the Tijuca National Park where we will board the famous tourist train to take you to the famous Christ the redeemer statue, considered the largest Art Deco statue in the world. The statue is 39.6 meters (130 ft.) tall, including its 9.5 meter (31 feet) pedestal, and 30 meters (98 ft.) wide. It weighs 635 tons (700 short tons), and is located at the peak of the 700 meters (2,300 ft.) Corcovado mountain in the Tijuca Forest National Park overlooking the city. It is one of the tallest of its kind in the world. A symbol of Christianity, the statue has become an icon of Rio and Brazil. It is made of reinforced concrete and soapstone, and was constructed between 1922 and 1931. Once we reach the top of the hill you will enjoy a wonderful view over the city. After the Christ, we will have a panoramic tour of the most beautiful beaches in the world like Ipanema and Copacabana. Then you will continue the excursion with a visit of Sugar Loaf. With the cable car to reach the top of the hill we will visit the two mountains with also another great view of the Guanabara Bay and Niteroi. Without doubt this is the best excursion in Brazil. 

HISTORICAL SALVADOR - BRSAL04

This excursion will take you through the most interesting historic and cultural places of Salvador. Departing from the port in a motor coach we will make a stop at Farol da Barra, the first military construction of Salvador and known as the city's postal card. It includes a walking tour through the historic part of the city, starting with the Praça da Se and the Municipal Square overlooking the Todos os Santos bay. The tour also includes an inside view of the Igreja da Ordem Terceira de São Francisco, built in the XVII century and with a marvelous stone façade recalling the Spanish baroque style and one of the most important churches in Bahia state. We will continue the walking tour until reaching Jorge Amado Foundation for an outside visit. After the Pelourinho the tour will proceed to the lower part of town to visit the Mercado Modelo the famous handcraft shop before returning to the pier. Remarks: We advise guests to wear hats and comfortable shoes. This tour includes walking on uneven path and cobble stones. 

Your first stop will be at an old mill in a place where you can feast on dry figs, cheese, Dalmatian dry-cured ham, fresh fruit juice, coffee and cake as well as have a chance to sample the olive oil made at the mill. Suitably fortified, the next bike leg takes you to Brajkovic for a wine-tasting session. The tour concludes with your return to Dubrovnik by coach and to your cruise ship. Please note: please wear comfortable trousers, a short-sleeved shirt, sports shoes and sunscreen (for summer calls), and take water with you. The itinerary may change to suit the group, weather or similar. Adjustable tour bikes of different sizes will be provided. The bike route is downhill and uphill on proper roads.

Rising up behind the beautiful walled city of Dubrovnik, a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1979, is Srđ Mountain, your first stop on this tour of extraordinary views and mediaeval fortifications. A cable car ride - an experience in itself - will take you to the top, where you can then look forward to a stunning panorama of Dubrovnik, the archipelago, the town of Cavtat and, on clear days, even Italy in the distance. To add to your enjoyment of these breathtaking vistas, a drink will be served in a mountainside bar. Leaving Srđ behind and taking the cable car back down, you will move on to Dubrovnik's world-famous city walls. Totalling nearly 2 km in length, an unbroken chain of fortresses, towers and bastions securely girdles the city, preventing the ingress of enemies in times gone by. Starting at the main street of the old town, you will first go on an orientation walk before some time will be yours to spend as you please in this special place. A shuttle bus ride back to your ship then ends your tour. Please note: at the discretion of the cable car operators, the service may be suspended entirely in the event of strong winds for reasons of safety. Guests are recommended to wear light clothing, sunscreen and a hat as well as to take a bottle of water during the summer months. There may be some queues at the parking area when returning from the old town to the ship and at the cable
